3. TRANSCRIPT: Please attach a photo copy transcript of your college and/or university record with your application.

4. BUDGET: Please provide a one page budget for the travel and study proposed.

Although not required, it would be useful to the selection committee to know that the foreign institution is prepared to accept you should you receive the scholarship. If you can obtain such a letter please provide a copy to the committee.

It may be sent separately but not before February 1.

Please do not alter or retype the application. Do not send any additional materials that are not required.
